

Rolling Green Park  
July 28, 1945

The thirty-third annual Reunion of the Herrold Family was held at Rolling Green Park, Saturday, July 28, 1945.

The business session was held at the tables above the bus station at 2 p.m. The meeting was called to order by the president, Dewey Herrold. The minutes were read and approved.

It was moved by Mrs. Ella Fisher and seconded by Dr. Chas. Fisher to have the business session of the Reunion at 2 p.m. again next year.

The election of officers was held, Dr. Chas. Fisher presiding. It was moved and seconded to reelect all the old officers excepting secretary. Motion carried. The officers were:

The offering amounted to \$6.19. The bill for printing of cards was \$4.50.
