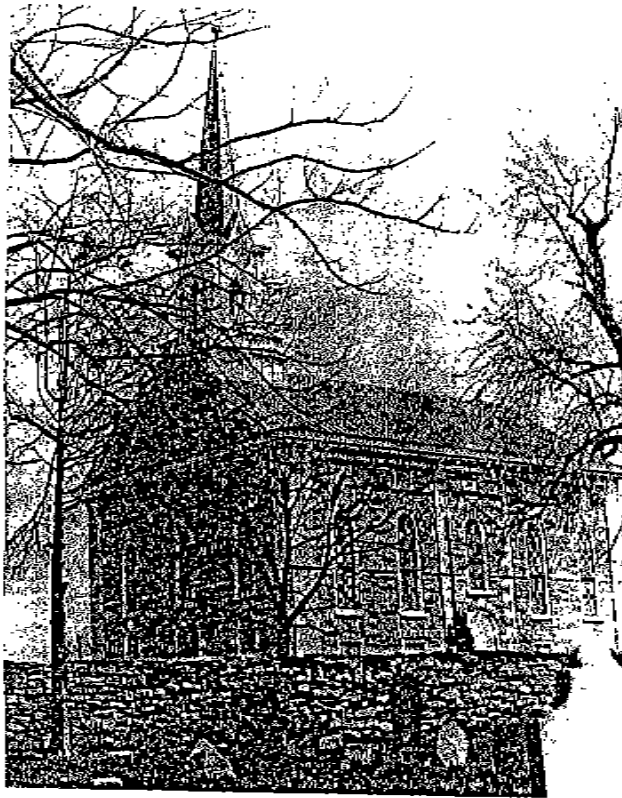

1. HERROLD ANCESTRY BOOK. Published in 2000.
 2. SNYDER COUNTY PIONEERS. By Dr. Charles A. Fisher, reprinted in 2001.
 3. HERROLD MONUMENT IN STOUCHBURG, PA. Incorrect dates for George Christoph Herrold and his wife, Maria Sheelkopf (1692 - 1760) were corrected in 2001. Cost: \$375.00.
 4. PIONEER CEMETERY. Split rail fence erected 2001. Cost: \$983.00.
 5. PIONEER CEMETERY. Concrete walkway and steps constructed, 2002. Cost: \$916.00
 6. PROJECT TO BE COMPLETED. Monument for *Anna Maria Benesch Herrold*, the Mother of all Snyder County Herrolds, to be placed in the old Pioneer Cemetery. Estimated cost: \$1,000. 40% of the funding is in place.
 6. PROJECT UNDER CONSIDERATION. Reprint HERROLD ANCESTRY BOOK, with updated genealogy. This would be spiral bound and would cost approximately \$40 to \$50.
